Sub. Recognition Certificate for the school under sub-rule (4) of rule 15 of Right of Children to free and Compulsory Education Rule, 2010 for the purpose of section 18 of Right of Children to free and Compulsory Education Act 2009.

Dear Sir/Madam,

With reference to your application dated 31-08-2020 and subsequent correspondence with the school/inspection in this regard, I convey the grant for provisional recognition to the Rajiv International School, NH-2 Delhi-Agra road, chatikra, MATHURA for Class 1st to Class 8th for a period of three years- 2020-21 to 2022-2023.

The above sanction is subject to fulfillment of following conditions:-

1. The grant for recognition is not extendable and does not in any way imply any obligation to recognize/affiliate beyond Class 8th.

2. The school shall abide by the provisions of Right of Children to free and Compulsory Education Act, 2009 (annexure 1) and the Right of Children to free and Compulsory Education Rule, 2010 (annexure 2).

3. The school shall admit in class 1 (or in pre-school class, as the case may be) to the extent of % of the strength of that class, children belonging to weaker section and disadvantaged group in the neighbourhood and provide free and compulsory elementary education till its completion.

4. For the children referred to in paragraph 3, the School shall be reimbursed in accordance with the provisions of sub-section (2) of section 12 of the Act. To receive such reimbursements school shall maintain a separate bank account.

5. The Society/School shall not collect any capitation fee and subject the child or his or her parent or guardian to any screening procedure.

6. The school shall not deny admission to any child for lack of age of poor shall adhere to the provisions of section 15 of the Act. The School shall ensure—

(a) no child admitted shall be held back in any class or expelled from school till the completion of elementary education in a school.

(b) no child shall be subjected to physical punishment or mental harassment.

(c) no child is required to pass any board examination till the completion of elementary education.

(d) Every child is completing elementary education shall be awarded a certificate as laid down under rule 25.

(e) inclusion of students with disabilities/special needs as per provision of the act.

(f) The teachers are recruited with minimum qualification as laid under section 23(1) of the act. Provided further that the current teachers who, at the commencement of this act do not possess minimum qualifications shall acquire such minimum qualifications within a period of 5 years.

(g) The teachers perform its duties specified laid under section 24(1) of the act; and

(h) The school shall not engage himself for private teaching activities.

(7) The school shall follow the syllabus on the basis of curriculum laid down by appropriate authority.

(12) The school is not run for profit to any individual, group or association of individual, group or association or individuals or any other persons.

(13) The accounts should be audited and certified by a chartered accountant and proper accounts statements should be prepared as per rules. A copy each of the statements of accounts should be sent to the District education officer every year.


(14) The recognition code Number allotted to your school is 2131424. This may please be noted and quoted for any correspondence with this office.


